- Welcome Kee Zublin, South's new principal: Beautification day and parent committee. Park on the sides and go through the front.
- Finances: Morgan going over the FOS finances. Going over the team balances.
- Insurance: Update of insurance policy currently in place: Do we want to fund a youth camp post season? We needed to have two years of liability insurance, but that has expired and we no longer need it. Decision was to move to event riders, instead of carrying the insurance on the main account. This is a new expense for FOS, thinking about how to pay for insurance in the future? (20 teams-possibly charge the teams to participate in FOS as a way to cover the remaining \$157 balance) Steve noted that there is a national organization that has a day insurance coverage for sports camps. This is for off season sports activities.

Silent auction goes to teams directly. General fundraising: both to the grant and to the endowment. This event is both celebrating the honorees, as well as fundraise. Suggestion of an assembly to promote the FOS celebration.
- Building: Building realignment/construction for more secure front entry at South
- Parking at the Football games: Traffic/Parking at UO football fundraiser along with existing catering block update. Catering meeting on Aug. 24 ${ }^{\text {th }}$. Rico spoke about the tram: as a fundraiser, the baseball team currently utilizes this this tram system. (Seth Karpinski: coordinating the concessions).
